A Note on Worship on Holy Thursday.

This day is referred to as Maundy Thursday, taken from the Latin word for commandment. From the Gospel of John, we recall the New Commandment that Jesus gives his disciples that they love one another. We recall the setting of the Last Supper as we bless, break, pour out and share in the remembrance of the Lord. And the Service of Tenebrae is from the Latin meaning shadows. In keeping with centuries old traditions, we read the Passion Story in 12 portions representing the 12 disciples, and through the extinguishing of the candles, participate in the darkness of the week.
