A note on the music: Olivier Messiaen (1908-1992) was a French composer and organist. Written when he was only 20, "La colombe" arguably reflects his interests both in birdsong and in Christian mysticism (since the dove is a well-known symbol of the Holy Spirit).

In "La cathédrale engloutie," Claude Debussy (1862-1918) portrays the legend of a cathedral in Brittany, France which sank into the ocean but which rises up on clear days, when the bells, Gregorian chant, and organ music can be heard.
