Located at the heart of the building where the old joins with new, our Food Table attracts busy people looking for delicious kitchen creations and makes a chunk of change in the process.

We need you to contribute your pies, cakes, muffins, scones, whatever goodies you can make at home and bring to Jean and Christine on Friday afternoon, November 17, or early Saturday, November 18. These should be goodies that do NOT need refrigeration, so the Wrentham Board of Health remains our friend. And baking with grandchildren can be a holiday tradition.

We NEVER have enough pies. Big sellers are the mini-pies that easily serve two people.

Small bags of cookies and muffins also disappear. Perhaps you have some recipes that can be made ahead and frozen. (Archeologists in the Holy Land recently uncovered a papyrus poll of the 12 disciples, voting for their favorite cookie. The results: chocolate chip, 6; brownies, 5; snickerdoodles, 1. Some things never change.) And candy! Fudge goes fast.
