2024 Thanksgiving Ingathering

LARGE BOX HAS BEEN PLACED IN FELLOWSHIP HALL FOR ANY DONATED ADULT AND CHILD WINTERWARE

Displaced migrant families are attempting to adjust to temporary housing locally in neighboring Plainville. Although basic meals and housing are being addressed, the reasons for leaving their homeland are complex; extreme poverty, threats from gang violence, war, persecution and environmental devastation. Family members are seeking employment when authorized and the children are entering the local school system. These are tremendous goals to achieve while facing the challenge of acclimating to a new environment and a strange culture.

In an effort to provide comfort and compassion, use the canvas bag to collect:

Adults: Soaps, Chap sticks, journals, dictionaries, feminine hygiene products, toiletry products, winter hats, gloves and scarves, first aid kits

Children: books, mittens, baby supplies, winter hats, juice boxes, small toys

All bags should be returned to the church Ingathering Sunday, November 24th
