People: Let us hear joy and gladness again.
Leader: Restore to us the joy of your salvation.
People: Sustain us in a willing spirit.
Leader: Do not cast us away from your presence.

Leader: We confess our love of worldly goods.

People: We confess our negligence in prayer and worship.

Leader: And we confess our disregard for the greater truth.

People: Accept our repentance for the wrongs we have done.

Leader: For turning from human need and suffering.

People: For our indifference to injustice and violence.

Leader: For our uncharitable thoughts towards our neighbors.

People: And for our waste and pollution of your Holy Creation.

Leader: Restore us O God with your Holy Spirit.

People: Receive our prayers in your great mercy. Amen.
