In the Garden

Leader: And they went out to Gethsemane, and Jesus said:

People: Crucify him.

Leader: And Pilate asked, "Why, what evil has he done?" But they shouted all the

more:

People: Crucify him!

Leader: And the soldiers led Jesus out and placed a purple cloak upon him and a crown of thorns. They struck his head with a reed, spit on him and knelt before

him saying:

People: Hail, hail! King of the Jews!

Leader: They led him out and compelled a passerby, Simon of Cyrene to carry his cross. And they brought him to the place called Golgotha. They offered him wine mixed with myrrh, but he did not take it. It was nine o'clock when they crucified him. And those who passed by derided him saying:

People: You who would destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save yourself. Come down from the cross!

Leader: So also, the chief priests with the scribes mocked him saying:

People: He saved others. He cannot save himself. Let the Anointed One come down from the cross that we may see and believe.
